ORDINANCE NO. 18-14

AN AMENDATORY ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6F.03, ARTICLE F, CHAPTER V OF ORDINANCE NO. 17-10, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE 2017 REVISED REVENUE CODE OF THE CITY OF BAGO.

Explanatory Note:

WHEREAS, in a letter submitted to the August Body by Dr. Allan F. Abayon, he requested that amendments be effected to the Ordinance to set forth conditions in the availment of the benefits for local officials and employees of the free services and medicines of Bago City Hospital, to be able to judiciously manage local resources and ensure a fair and regulated extension of said benefits;

WHEREAS, after thorough deliberation on the matter, the August Body found the request meritorious and is of the consensus to institutionalize the grant of said benefit subject to the conditions set forth to ensure that the same is available to officials and employees without sacrificing the meager resources of the local government.

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion of SP Member Cleo F. Gaudite, duly seconded by SP Members Marina Javellana-Yao, Carlos E. Mondia, Ma. Femmy A. Martir, be it enacted by the Sanggunian Panlungsod, that:

SECTION 1. Section 6F.03, Article F, Chapter V of Ordinance No. 17-10, is accordingly amended and shall now read as follows:

“Section 6F.03 Administrative Provision.

- a) X x x x x x x .
- b) X x x x x x x .
- c) X x x x x x x .
- d) Officials and Employees of the City Government of Bago, after deducting the senior citizen, PWD benefits and Philhealth coverage, shall be exempted from payment of all fees and charges herein provided up to PhP10,000.00 per year except for medicines and other laboratory and radiology services not available at the hospital or any health facility having an agreement with the City, subject to the following conditions that:
 - a. He/she is confined at Bago City Hospital, however laboratory and radiology services fees may be included for outpatient;
 - b. Laboratory/Radiology request is done by a medical officer of Bago City Hospital or City Health Office, self-request is not allowed;
 - c. Only medicines listed in the Philippine National Drug Formulary and oxygen consumed during confinement shall be included in the yearly benefit, take home medicines are not covered; and
 - d. A local government issued identification card or a certification from the HRMO proving active status shall be secured by the patient to be

SECTION 2. Separability Clause. If for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions thereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Repealing Clause. All Ordinances, rules and regulations, or parts thereof, which provisions are in conflict with, or contrary to, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended and modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. Effectivity Clause. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval or after the same be published in full for three (3) consecutive days in a newspaper of local circulation, whichever comes later.




