WHEREAS, in a letter submitted to this Office, Mr. Cornelio E. Segundino, OIC-City Treasurer, this City, requested for approval the grant of two days leave by City Revenue Collection Officers as a form of incentives in their exemplary performance in exceeding their collection targets;

WHEREAS, in a Committee Hearing called for the purpose, Atty. Aaron R. Lirazan, City Legal Officer and Ms. Tricia Y. Matti, HRMO IV/City Administrator-Designate, clarified that there is no legal basis for the grant of said proposed incentive; and

WHEREAS, after a thorough deliberation on the matter and upon recommendation of the Committee on Human Resource Development and Welfare, the Sangguniang Panlungsod is of the consensus not to approve the said proposal for lack of legal basis.
