RESOLUTION NO. 10-291

RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR TO CREATE “TASK FORCE BUKAS KLASE” WITH THE END IN VIEW OF CONDUCTING ON-THE-SPOT INSPECTION AS SOON AS SCHOOLS OPEN SO THAT NO STUDENTS SHALL BE ALLOWED IN GAMING STATIONS AND OTHER ENTERTAINMENT ESTABLISHMENT DURING CLASS HOURS AND THAT NO STORES SHALL BE ALLOWED TO SELL INTOXICATING LIQUORS AND CIGARETTES TO MINORS AROUND THE SCHOOL VICINITY TO PROMOTE PEACE AND ORDER AND A CONDUCTIVE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT IN SCHOOLS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF BAGO.

WHEREAS, government and school officials, student officers and parents voiced out their concerns over the peace and order situation around the schools;

WHEREAS, these concerns emanate from their observations that stores near the schools sell intoxicating liquors and cigarettes especially to minors, that students and pupils enter gaming stations during class hours, and that loud noise comes from karaokes in establishments near the schools; further, drunk students are often involved in fighting and some carry deadly weapons into the campus;

WHEREAS, the said Task Force shall involve representatives from the following agencies;

1. DEP Ed
2. CSWDO
3. PNP
4. Bago City College
5. City Treasurer
6. Barangay Captain where the Concerned School is found
7. PTA President of the Concerned School
8. Student Council President of the Concerned School
9. City Health Office
10. Sanggunian Panlungsod

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion of SP Member Bernadette M. Somcio, duly seconded by SP Members Loreto N. Cauntoy, Ruben T. Torres, Serafin Z. Jara, Victor B. Javellana, Rosario F. Gaudite, the Sanggunian

RESOLVES, as it is hereby resolved to urge the Honorable City Mayor to create “Task Force Bukas Klase” with the end in view of conducting on-the-spot inspection as soon as schools open so that no students shall be allowed in gaming stations and other entertainment establishment during class hours and that no stores shall be allowed to sell intoxicating liquors and cigarettes to minors around the school vicinity to promote peace and order and a conducive learning environment in schools within the jurisdiction of the City of Bago.
