ORDINANCE NO. 20-35

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLES V, VII, VIII, IX and X OF ORDINANCE NO. 17-12 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE 2017 COMPREHENSIVE TRICYCLE OPERATIONS CODE OF BAGO CITY.

WHEREAS, Section 458 (3) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall, subject to the guidelines prescribed by the Department of Transportation and Communications, regulate the operation of tricycle and grant franchises for the operation thereof within the territorial jurisdiction of the city;

WHEREAS, tricycles have been the most effective and most often used mode of transportation within the City of Bago;

WHEREAS, committee meetings were called to assess the present situation of the tricycle transportation industry within the City and it was revealed that there are supervening circumstances affecting Ordinance No. 17-12, Series of 2017 which needs to be addressed through an amendment, particularly the addition of tricycle route in Barangay Ma-ao;

WHEREAS, after a careful deliberation, it is the consensus of the members of the August Body that these supervening circumstances should be addressed for the Ordinance to be responsive to the present changes and also to keep abreast of the current economic situations of our city and our nation;

NOW, **THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Sanggunian Panlungsod of the City of Bago in a session assembled and on motion by SP Member Sergio T. Piansay, unanimously seconded by SP Members present, that:

SECTION 1. – Article II, Article V, Article VII and Article X are accordingly amended to read as follows:

"Section 1 – Every tricycle for hire shall be allowed to operate in one (1) zone only. The different areas of the city are hereby designated and zoned as follows:

Section 2. Tricycle units accepting and delivering passengers to and from areas outside the territorial jurisdiction of the City shall likewise be assigned a tricycle terminal by the <u>Traffic Management Division of the City Mayor's Office</u> and shall not be allowed to accept passengers other than from their assigned terminal except when otherwise allowed under this ordinance.

All TODA's should ensure their compliance to the requirement of the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and other government regulating agencies, otherwise the same shall be a ground for the City to revoke their accreditation.

SECTION 2. –Any other ordinance or portions thereof passed which are inconsistent in whole or in part with this ordinance are hereby modified or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 3. – If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in force and affect.

SECTION 4.—This Ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the City Mayor and the required posting of ten (10) days in three (3) conspicuous places in the City Proper and in all Barangay Halls in the City.
