ORDINANCE NO. 19-06

AN AMENDATORY ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 19-03 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE WAGE OF CASUAL PERSONNEL UNDER JOB ORDER IN THE CITY OF BAGO.

WHEREAS, in a letter sent to this August body, Honorable Nicholas M. Yulo, City Mayor requested for the amendment for the purpose of clarifying the nature of eligibilities viz-a-viz the work assignment of casual laborers;

WHEREAS, the August body is of the consensus to favorably grant the said request as it eliminates confusion as to the nature of eligibilities that will warrant availment of higher salaries by casual laborers.

On Motion of SP Member Ma. Josefa Y. Matti, duly seconded by SP Member Ma. Femmy A. Martir, Danilo U. Famoso, Marina Javellana-Yao, Cleo F. Gaudite, the Sanggunian

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bago, that:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 19-03, shall now read as follows:

SECTION 2. X x x x x.

Skilled workers shall be composed of casuals in the different Offices with Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) and Civil Service Commission (CSC) eligibilities related to their work assignments. Their salary shall be PhP350.00 per day.

SECTION 2. Separability Clause. If for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions thereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.


SECTION 3. Repealing Clause. All Ordinances, rules and regulations, or parts thereof, which provisions are in conflict with, or contrary to, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended and modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. Effectivity Clause. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


