**ORDINANCE NO. 19-17**

**AN AMENDATORY ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6K.01, ARTICLE K, CHAPTER 5 OF ORDINANCE NO. 17-10, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE 2017 REVISED REVENUE CODE OF THE CITY OF BAGO.**

**WHEREAS**, the Unified Student Financial Assistance System for Tertiary Education (UniFast) requested Bago City College (BCC) to submit the list of fees and charges of the institution to facilitate payment by the national government with suggestion that they should be innovative in ensuring that the opportunity for a free tertiary education be fully availed of by the students;

**WHEREAS**, there are fees and charges stipulated in the 2017 Revised Revenue Code that does not conform to the menu of fees and charges allowed by UniFast, hence the BCC administration embedded some of these fees and changed their nomenclature for the purpose and submitted the same for their approval;

**WHEREAS**, UniFast, after series of assessments and corrections, approved of the fees as submitted, however the nomenclature and amount of fees and charges does not conform to what is prescribed under the 2017 Revised Revenue Code, hence, necessitating the latter's amendment.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bago, that:

**SECTION 1.** Article K, Chapter 5 of Ordinance No. 17-10, shall now read as follows:

**Article K. BAGO CITY COLLEGE CHARGES**

**Section 6K.01 Imposition of Fees.** - Unless specifically provided, the following shall be the prescribed semestral fees of the Bago City College:

Furthermore, students enrolling for summer classes shall pay the corresponding fees for registration fee, tuition fee, salaries of teachers and adjustments in the cost of utilities and maintenance, and other necessary academic fees as may be assessed by the institution.


**SECTION 2. Separability Clause.** If for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions thereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3. Repealing Clause.** All Ordinances, rules and regulations, or parts thereof, which provisions are in conflict with, or contrary to, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended and modified accordingly.

**SECTION 4. Effectivity Clause.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


