RESOLUTION DENYING FAVORABLE RECOMMENDATION TO THE APPLICATION FOR COMMERCIAL SAND AND GRAVEL QUARRY PROJECT OF MS. GLYNIS AMOR C. CADUHADA, WITH AN AREA OF 1.8819 HECTARES LOCATED OVER A PORTION OF MARAGANDANG RIVER, BARANGAY DON JORGE L. ARANETA, BAGO CITY.

WHEREAS, in a letter dated June 10, 2019 from Mr. Vicente Mesias, SEMS/City ENRO-Designate, favorably endorsed by the Honorable City Mayor and addressed to this Honorable body, the documentary requirements of the application of MS. GLYNIS AMOR C. CADUHADA, for a favorable endorsement of CSAG Quarry Project with an area of 1.8819 hectares located over a portion of Maragandang River, Barangay Don Jorge L. Araneta, Bago City within the 500 lineal meters distance from the hanging bridge constructed by the City Government;

WHEREAS, this matter was referred to the Committee on Environmental Protection for study to which after a series of Committee Meetings and hearings, they recommended to the plenary to deny the request for favorable endorsement by the applicant premised on the current state of the hanging bridge which as per report by the City Engineering Office already have cracks in the slabs most likely caused by the movements of the embankment, and the policy observed by the local government not to allow quarrying activities within the 500 meters distance of existing structures to ensure its stability;

WHEREAS, after a thorough deliberation, the August body is of the consensus to conform with the recommendation cited by the Committee as relayed by its Chairperson Hon. Jozsef Mark Dexter M. Somcio;
