**RESOLUTION APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 01, SERIES OF 2023 OF THE JOINT INTER-AGENCY TASK FORCE (IATF) AND CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL, BAGO CITY, ENTITLED: "RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CRITERIA ON GIVING AID TO INDIVIDUALS IN CRISIS SITUATION (AICS) AFFECTED BY THE TRANSBOUNDARY ANIMAL DISEASE OUTBREAK IN BAGO CITY".**

**WHEREAS**, Indorsement letter dated June 6, 2023, from the Honorable City Mayor, respectfully referred to this Honorable body, the request for approval of Resolution No. 01, Series of 2023 of the Joint IATF and City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, Bago City;

**WHEREAS**, as presented by the City Veterinary Office through their report as of 05 June 2023, 20 Barangays have already been affected by the Transboundary Animal Disease outbreak;

**WHEREAS**, out of the 20 Barangays affected, there were 592 swine raisers affected with a total of 7,059 hog mortalities with estimated losses of Php69,483,000.00 based on the criteria released by the Provincial Government of Negros Occidental;

**WHEREAS**, the criteria for giving aid to individuals in crisis situations affected by the Transboundary Animal Disease outbreak in Bago City with details as follows:

Hog Mortality per Heads	Assistance
1 – 4 heads	P3,000.00
5 – 10 heads	P5,000.00
11 and above heads	P8,000.00

**WHEREAS**, after a thorough deliberation on the matter, this August Body is of the consensus to approve said Resolution;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, upon motion of SP Member Victor Michael A. Javellana, unanimously seconded by SP Members present, the Sangguniang Panlungsod

**RESOLVES**, as it is hereby resolved, to approve Resolution No. 01, Series of 2023 of the Joint Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) and City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, Bago City, entitled: "Resolution Approving the Criteria on Giving Aid to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) Affected by the Transboundary Animal Disease Outbreak in Bago City".
