RESOLUTION NO. 23-329

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY OF BAGO, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL UNDER THE STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO THE COMBINED EFFECTS OF THE ENHANCED SOUTHWEST MONSOON BY SUPER TYPHOON "GORING".

WHEREAS, in a letter dated September 4, 2023, from the Honorable City Mayor, respectfully referred to this Honorable body, the Resolution No. 15, Series of 2023 of the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (CDRRMC), Bago City, entitled: "Resolution Recommending the City of Bago under a State of Calamity Due to the Combined Effects of the Enhanced Southwest Monsoon by Super Typhoon "Goring";

WHEREAS, presented by the CDRRMC and the City Social Welfare and Development Office through their reports as of September 1, 2023, 20 Barangays with 5,590 families composed of 17,717 individuals have already been affected by the wide-scale flooding throughout the city;

WHEREAS, widespread destruction of crops, fisheries, and other agricultural products, affecting 34% of farmers and fisherfolks with a damage report of P138,656,698.73 as reported by the City Agricultures Office;

WHEREAS, losses of P4,838,000.00 of livestock were reported by the City Veterinary's Office;

WHEREAS, the Bago City Hospital was flooded up to 0.5-1 meter of flood water where hospital operations disrupted since 28 August 2023 and damaged almost P40,289,000.00 pesos hospital equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion of SP Member Jake Patrick Y. Torres, unanimously seconded by SP Members present, the Sangguniang Panlungsod

RESOLVES, as it is hereby resolved, to declare the City of Bago, Negros Occidental under the State of Calamity Due to the Combined Effects of the Enhanced Southwest Monsoon by Super Typhoon "Goring".
