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**RESOLUTION NO. 23-044**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE MATERNAL, NEONATAL, CHILD HEALTH AND NUTRITION (MNCHN) SERVICE DELIVERY NETWORK (SDN) COMPOSED OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PROVIDERS AND ASSIGNMENT OF PRIORITY FAMILIES IN THE SDN FOR THE CITY OF BAGO.**

**WHEREAS**, presented in session assembled for adoption is the Maternal, Neonatal, Child Health and Nutrition (MNCHN) Service Delivery Network (SDN) composed of Public and Private Providers and Assignment of priority families in the SDN for the City of Bago;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bago supports the attainment of Millennium Development Goals 4 and 5 which are the reduction of infant and maternal mortalities and the implementation of Maternal Newborn Child Health and Nutrition (MNCHN) program to address concerns and improve the health outcomes related to MNCHN;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Health (DOH) issued policies and implemented programs to address issues and improve outcomes on maternal new born child health and nutrition to include the following: a) AO 2008-2009 – Maternal, Neonatal Child Health and Nutrition Strategy; AO 2010-0036 – Aquino Health Agenda and Kalusugan Pangkalahatan Execution Plan; d) the MNCHN Strategy Manual Operations, 2011 (2<sup>nd</sup> Edition); e) AO 2012-2009 National Strategy Towards Reducing Unmet Need for Modern Family Planning as a Means to Achieving MDGs for Maternal Health; f) AO 2012-0012 Rules and Regulations Governing the New Classification of Hospitals and Other Health Facilities in the Philippines; and g) Department Order 2012 – 0120: Guidelines on the Execution of the 2012 Family Health and Responsible Parenting Budget for Maternal, Neonatal and Child Health and Nutrition Grants to LGUs; and most recently the h) Reproductive Health Law approved in December 2012;

**WHEREAS**, recently, DOH launched the Universal Health Care High Impact Five (UHC-HIF) Plan which focuses on five critical interventions: 1) reducing maternal deaths; 2) reducing infants deaths; 3) reducing under five deaths; 4) Halt the spread of HIV-AIDs and 5) Establishing functional Service Delivery Network (SDN);

**WHEREAS**, the establishment of a functional Service Delivery Network (SDN) is considered as one of the key interventions to ensure that the first 4 indicators will be achieved and sustained. To guide the LGUs, the DOH issued Administrative Order 2014-0046, "Defining the Service Delivery Networks for Universal Health Care or Kalusugan Pangkalahatan" to effectively and efficiently cover the needs of priority groups and the general population in an integrated, coordinated and continuous manner;

**WHEREAS**, Service Delivery Network (SDN) as defined in the MNCHN Manual of Operation as the network of public or private health facilities and providers within the province or city wide health systems, offering a core package of health care services in an integrated and coordinated manner similar to the local health referral system;

**WHEREAS**, establishment of the functional SDN at the city level will ensure access to quality care for every mother, child and priority families in need of health services.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, upon motion of SP Member Victor Michael A. Javellana, unanimously seconded by SP Members present, the Sangguniang Panlungsod



RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE NATIONAL POLICY ON HAZARD MANAGEMENT IN EMERGENCIES AND DISASTERS

WHEREAS, disaster is a sudden and calamitous event that brings on a deadly destruction of substantial property, human life, and general disruption of communities;

WHEREAS, the policy is to guide the Local Government Unit in providing and restoring the food and nutrition objectives in times of emergency and disaster, through a well-organized, strategic and efficient management, in anticipation and disaster, including an early, surveillance, rapid nutritional assessment, and implementation of nutrition interventions;

WHEREAS, after a thorough deliberation on the matter, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bago is of the consensus to adopt the National Policy on Disaster Management in Emergencies and Disasters;

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion of SP Member Victor Michael A. Javellana, unanimously seconded by SP Members present, the Sangguniang Panlungsod

RESOLVES, as it is hereby resolved, to adopt the National Policy on Nutrition Management in Emergencies and Disasters;


